



Union Members in Pennsylvania — 2022

In 2022, union members accounted for 12.7 percent of wage and salary workers in Pennsylvania, compared with 12.9 percent in 2021, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported today. Regional Commissioner Alexandra Hall Bovee noted that the union membership rate for the state was at its peak in 1989, when it averaged 20.9 percent, and at its low point in 2017 and 2019 at 12.0 percent. (See [chart 1](#) and [table A](#).) Nationwide, union members accounted for 10.1 percent of employed wage and salary workers in 2022. The rate was down from 10.3 percent in 2021, primarily the result of a disproportionately large increase in the number of total wage and salary employment compared with the increase in the number of union members. The 2022 unionization rate (10.1 percent) is the lowest on record. Since 1989, when comparable state data became available, union membership rates in Pennsylvania have been above the U.S. average.

Pennsylvania had 715,000 union members in 2022. In addition to these members, another 52,000 wage and salary workers in Pennsylvania were represented by a union on their main job or covered by an employee association or contract while not union members themselves.




Consumer Price Index, Northeast Region – October 2023

Area prices unchanged over the past month, up 2.7 percent from a year ago

Prices in the Northeast Region, as measured by the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U), were unchanged in October, the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reported today. (See [table A](#).) Regional Commissioner Alexandra Hall Bovee noted that was due to counteracting price changes in the energy index (down 2.2 percent) and increases in the food index (up 0.5 percent) and the all items less food and energy index (up 0.1 percent). (Data in this report are not seasonally adjusted. Accordingly, month-to-month changes may reflect the impact of seasonal influences.)

Over the last 12 months, the Northeast all items CPI-U index increased 2.7 percent. The October advance was primarily due to a 3.4-percent rise in the all items less food and energy index, which was led by increases within the shelter index. The food index rose 3.1 percent—the smallest rise in 2023 so far—as increases continued to diminish since the year began. The energy index decreased 5.8 percent and has trended down every month since March. (See [table 1](#).) This is the eighth consecutive month that the 12-month change in the all items index has been lower than the all items less food and energy index. (See [chart 1](#).) The October all items less food and energy index increase was the lowest since September 2021.
